The Off the Beaten Path website allows studio visitors to browse a full list of all the participating artists or a list of the artists on each tour, featuring samples of each artist's work. Interactive maps are accessible on smart phones for traveling from tour stop to stop.

All studios on the tours will be open for all ages, free of charge, from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. on each day of the tour.

The Lake County tour includes studios in Eustis, Mount Dora, Leesburg, Tavares and Weirsdale. The East Volusia Tour includes studios in Ormond Beach, Port Orange, New Smyrna Beach and Edgewater, while the West Volusia tour features locations in DeLand, Lake Helen and Orange City.

Every year, art patrons, collectors, curators and decorators, as well as families and children, are welcomed into the studios to meet the artists in their work environments, watch demonstrations, enjoy light refreshments, and shop for unique original works of art. The varied types of offerings include paintings, sculptures, textiles, jewelry, ceramics, woodworks, photography, printmaking, and illustration.

John Wilton, a spokesman for the event says, "The tours have been growing rapidly in popularity every year. After a couple of 'quiet' years due to Covid restrictions, people are once again getting out, exploring, and discovering new ideas."

Visitors enjoy a self-guided tour with easy-tofollow interactive maps on the website, along with artist information. Printable maps and artist lists are also available in the "Media and Maps" section on the website.



Opening Soon: Daytona Aquarium and Rainforest Adventure

Locals and visitors will soon be able to explore the wonders of the deep blue sea and the mysteries of lush rainforests at the Daytona Aquarium and Rainforest Adventure. The 70,000-square-foot experience will be located in Daytona Beach, at the shopping center on the northwest corner of International Speedway Boulevard and Nova Road. This is the first ever aquarium and rainforest experience to open in the area.

The grand opening for the first phase includes the aquarium, approximately 55,000 square feet, and is planned to open in early 2024. A hiring event took place on-site February 1, 2024 with the aquarium looking to fill top positions like Director of Operations, Guest Service Supervisor, Senior Aquarist and Reptile Keeper. Phase Two includes the Rainforest Adventure and plans for opening are within eight to twelve months after Phase One.

Plans for the aquarium take visitors on a breathtaking voyage under the sea through 40 separate tanks featuring a diverse array of marine life, featuring tropical fish, graceful sea turtles and mesmerizing jellyfish. The wow factor will be a 110,000-gallon tank where visitors can watch majestic sharks swim. The plans also include a 12,000-gallon touch pool where visitors can dip their hand into cool, shallow waters and be greeted by the velvety sensation of a gentle gliding stingray. Guests will also be able to tour habitats for frogs, alligators, crocodiles, lizards and other reptiles.

The indoor rainforest will immerse guests among tall trees, lush foliage and canopy overhead. Animal exhibits will showcase birds, sloths, tamarins, toucans and other exotic species. The site has the potential to also include otters, penguins and an outdoor waterfall

exhibit.

If that's not all, the experience will also have an educational lecture space, cafe, arcade and special event rooms for gatherings and birthdays. As the grand opening approaches, the anticipation for the extraordinary experience builds. This destination promises to be a haven for all nature enthusiasts and curious minds. The fusion of the ecosystems under one roof invites visitors to explore the magic of the oceans and the allure of the rainforest for an unforgettable exploration of the natural world.

According to the Daytona Aquarium & Rainforest Adventure's website,
DaytonaAquariumAndRainforest.com, guests can buy a daily pass or an annual membership. Daily passes will cost \$28.95 for adults and \$24.95 for children ages 2-12. Annual memberships will cost \$100 for adults and \$80 for kids. In comparison, the Daytona Aquarium and Rainforest Adventure is more than twice the size of the Sea Life Orlando

Aquarium - the Orlando venue is 25,000 square feet.

Her first care session, which I took part in while in my living room, involves testing different pressure points and muscle groups to get a feel for how




our nervous and lymphatic systems contribute to our skeletal alignment. I only know that because she explained her process along the way and she gave me some stretches to do after our appointment.






Ripe for the Picking

Oak Haven Farms and Winery - Sorrento, FL

While most of the country is thick in the doldrums of winter, Florida is in bloom and we are right in the midst of a very important time... strawberry season. Any parent will know the cost of berries a child consumes can break the bank. We go through multiple cartons a week of Avery's favorite fruit, so picking season is a big win for us!



There are plenty of u-pick farms throughout Florida offering up a variety of in-season produce throughout the year, ranging from citrus to veggies, and our family's other top item, blueberries. Over the years we've accumulated our favorite spots and Oak Haven Farms and Winery is on that list.

At Oak Haven, you'll find sprawling fields of ripe, juicy strawberries that are practically glowing red and begging to be picked. Upon arrival, you'll get a large box for your haul and directions. Be sure to ask the attendant where the best berries are that day, as it will vary from week to week as areas get picked out and new spots ripen. Pick with caution, as your selection is priced by the pound and it is easy to get carried away when you're hunting for the biggest, most perfect berry. A full box will be about 10 pounds, a half will be about five.

Avery screamed triumphantly as she found bigger and bigger berries, many larger than her little hands. Over the years, we've made our own strawberry ice cream and desserts with our picks, and planned to make jam for the first time this season. Sadly, our berries didn't last long enough in our hungry household to make it to the jar, but they were delicious all the same.

If you want your berries to last a bit longer, wash them when you get home and soak them for 15 minutes in a mixture of 8 cups of water with 2 Tablespoons of apple cider vinegar. Rinse thoroughly and allow to dry before storing them in a glass container in the fridge. This will not only clean your fruit well, it will help it to last longer, too.

After you've picked as much as you can, there's still plenty to do on the farm to fill the afternoon. We arrived before lunch so by the time we weighed in, we were ready for a snack. The on-site café (open on weekends) offers a variety of good eats and treats, loaded with strawberries of course! We decided to try out the strawberry shortcake loaded with ice cream and strawberry cheesecake. You can

even grab some hot dogs to roast yourself over the open fire out front beneath a massive shady oak.

In addition to the farm, Oak Haven also crafts their own wines from a variety of locally grown grapes, blueberries and, you guessed it, strawberries. You can sample five wines for just a dollar, and if you decide to



bring a bottle home, the dollar is discounted from your purchase. Avery partook in the "wine" tasting as well with her own sample glass of water so she could feel exceptionally fancy as well.

Everything at Oak Haven is family-operated and family-friendly! One of the co-owners, Harry, can often be spotted cruising around on his tractor to keep the farm running, while Karen can be found holding down the fort in the purchase stand and café. The adjacent fields hold grape vines for the wine, as well as a sunflower field where you can pick your own stems to take home with your berries. Alongside the fields are a few play areas for kids that Avery had a blast on, as well as ample picnic tables for your fruit feast, hot dog roast, or to grab a glass of wine and relax.

Be sure to plan ahead and check the farm's Facebook page for picking days before heading out. Busy weekends can result in no berries or a sudden cold front can prevent them from ripening in time for the next weekend, but the farm will announce if they plan to be closed. Strawberry season is only until March, so it's time to get picking!

Strawberry Cheesecake Pancakes

Preparation: Prep Time: 20 minutes • Cook Time: 20 minutes • Servings: 15 pancakes

Why not have breakfast and dessert on one plate with a batch of these Strawberry Cheesecake Pancakes! Fluffy cream cheese-stuffed pancakes, whipped cream, and homemade strawberry sauce - they totally blow any restaurant version out of the water with their decadence!







INGREDIENTS

Strawberry Topping

- •2 cups fresh strawberries cut in half
- 1/4 cup sugar
- 2 tablespoons lemon juice

Cheesecake Pancakes

- •2 cups all-purpose flour sifted
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 6 ounces cream cheese softened, divided
- 2 tablespoons granulated sugar
- 2 large eggs room temperature
- 1 cup buttermilk room temperature
- •2 tablespoons butter melted and cooled
- 1 teaspoon lemon juice
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- Whipped cream



INSTRUCTIONS

Strawberry Topping:

- Place the strawberries, sugar, and lemon juice in a saucepan set over medium-low heat. Bring to a low boil and cook 12-15 minutes, or until strawberries cook down and thicken.
- For a smoother sauce, mash the berries with the back of a spoon. Set aside and keep warm.

Cheesecake Pancakes:

- In a large mixing bowl, whisk together the flour, baking powder, and salt.
- In a separate bowl, use an electric mixer to beat 4 ounces of cream cheese and sugar together until smooth. Add the eggs one at a time until combined, then beat in the buttermilk, melted butter, lemon juice, and vanilla until smooth.
- Gently fold the wet ingredients into the flour mixture until just combined. Add the remaining cubed cream cheese and fold in gently. Allow the batter to rest for 10 minutes.
- Heat a pancake pan (or large frying pan or electric griddle) over medium heat. Lightly grease with oil or non-stick cooking spray.
- Pour 1/4 cup of batter per pancake onto the griddle and cook for 2-3 minutes until tops are slightly dry looking, with small air bubbles beginning to form. Flip, and continue cooking on the other side, 1-2 minutes, until golden brown. Keep pancakes warm in a low temperature oven while you work through the batter.
- Stack pancakes with layers of whipped cream & strawberry sauce and serve.



"I took a job flying seaplanes in Alaska. The money is good and I can't say no."





Fishaholic: February Report WAVE





Greetings from Captain Austin, bringing you the fishing report for the New Smyrna Beach area. What's going with this weather? It's been cold and rainy for what seems like the entire month of January. I can't remember a January that had so much rain and that's not normal. I can handle the cold. as some years it can be downright chilly, but all the rain has really made fishing a bit more challenging. The wintertime usually means clear skies and clear water but that's not been the case.

OK, so enough complaining about the weather - there are still a plethora of opportunities to catch fish. Outside of the weather, anglers should always consider the tide, water temperature and wind direction. If you plan ahead, your chances for success increase greatly out on the water.

Our winter residents - sheepshead and black drum - have been consistent and

should keep anglers busy into the spring. The black drum that are caught in our area are impressive in size with some fish over 30 pounds, so make sure you have the right tackle when targeting them. Sheepshead are great for kids as they put up a nice fight and don't require heavy tackle to catch.

Another wintertime resident, bluefish, are around in good numbers and can save the day when nothing else is biting. The bluefish we catch in Florida are usually not as big as the ones you find up north, but we occasionally catch fish over 10 pounds. Bluefish are not picky eaters and will devour everything in sight from dead bait to lures.

The snook and redfish fishing has been slow and probably won't get consistent until March, but vou never know. Both species are always around but can be much less active this time of year, this is especially true for snook which are essentially a tropical species and thrive in warm water. If we get some warm weather days in the backwaters where the waters warm quickly, the snook and redfish bite can get good. In the creeks and backwaters including Mosquito Lagoon, sea trout and redfish will be available in good numbers.

Hope you enjoyed the report and let us know if you'd like to get out on the water. We have some openings this month and would love to take you fishing.







fishing Report

January has passed, leaving behind memories of an exceptional month filled with tight lines and unforgettable fishing experiences. Finally, the arrival of some decently cold days allowed the fish to school up. While most were schools of redfish, we also encountered a variety of trout and smaller-sized snook. Florida's weather patterns can be quite unpredictable, making it challenging to secure consistent fishing conditions with more than just a day or two of cooler weather.

Our success mainly came from using Henn Lures, including the Lil' Shrimp, Croaker, Mud Guppy, and Shrinnow. These artificial baits proved highly effective in rapidly attracting fish. You can explore the range of baits and other accessories at HennLures.com. Additionally, live mullet yielded good results, especially when hooked just below the anal fin to keep the bait closer to the bottom where larger fish tend to reside.

In the past month, I've relaunched my YouTube channel, Tupat's Fishing Adventures. 
